

# 2026 Men's Tuesday Night League

## Rules

- Green fees are \$18 paid each week. The cart will add \$6 if you want to ride.
- League dues will be \$45 per man or \$180 per team.
- No play outs. Teams must tee off on the appointed times. Late players need to join their group in progress taking at least a bogey or whatever score will cause you to lose the hole and forfeiting the missed holes. Note the holes missed on the scorecard.
- It is permissible to start on one of the last couple holes of the nine you are scheduled for if approved by the starter and if all members of both teams arrive early and agree to do so.
- Pace of play is important. If you are more than one shot behind the group, then you're playing too slow.
- White stakes – out of bounds: replay the shot. If you think you may have gone out, hit a provisional.
- Red & Yellow stakes: Replay shot, 2 club lengths or line of flight. Talk to your opponent to decide where to play. Be sure to keep up the pace of play.
- You may move the ball no more than 6" in any fairway and rough only. The ball must be played down in all other situations. **High weeds do not count as rough.**
- Play clean and place on all plugged balls.
- No more than double par on par 4's and 5's. Maximum score on a par 3 is 7.
- All teams will participate in a season ending tournament. The finals will coincide with the season ending outing and cookout. Any player participating in the playoff rounds must have played at least 3

rounds during the regular season. The sub list must be utilized for any playoff substitute before a player from an eliminated team can be used.

- We will have a weekly skins game. The cost is \$15 due by the first week and will get you in the entire year. Skins money will be handed out during the first playoff week.
- New players are handicapped at 80% of their score for the first 2 rounds.
- Players receiving a forfeit will be scored against the ghost.
- 62 years and older can tee from the gold tees. Cannot change mid-season and must be made known so handicaps can be calculated accordingly.
- Lost balls in play will be played in the line of flight by penalty of one stroke. Talk to your opponent to decide where to play.
